## Judging Criteria – Lash Lift

Refore the Treatment – Natural Lash Assessment	30 total points
Natural Curl & Direction – The straighter and more disorganized the natural lashes are, the higher the score. Judges assess the complexity and challenge of the initial lash condition.	0 - 10 points
Natural Lash Length – The longer the lashes, the higher the score.	0 - 10 points
Lash Thickness – Thicker lashes are more difficult to work with and score higher accordingly.	0 - 10 points
After the Treatment – Technique & Aesthetic Evaluation	70 total points
<b>Overall Impression</b> – Visual harmony, appropriate curl choice, and general presentation.	0 - 10 points
Curl Quality – Judges assess the smoothness of the curl, without kinks, creases or lash damage.	0 - 10 points
<b>Symmetry</b> – Curl symmetry between both eyes, both as a whole and by zones.	0 - 10 points
<b>Tint Color Selection</b> – Matching the color to the client's hair, skin tone, and natural features.	0 - 10 points

<b>Tint Saturation</b> – Color intensity and uniform application from root to tip.	0 - 10 points
Clean Work – No leftover glue, tint, or lotion. Lashes should be clean, separated and neat at the base and throughout.	0 - 10 points
Rod Application Technique – Precision in lifting and positioning lashes onto the silicone rods. Lashes must be evenly spaced, parallel, and tensioned correctly with no crisscrossing or bending.	0 - 10 points
Penalty – Redness, damaged or cut natural/extension lashes	From -1 to -5 points

## Photos for Lash Lift Category

- 1. BEFORE Photo Side Profile
  Side view of the eye to assess the natural lash curl before the procedure.
- 2. AFTER Photo Side Profile
  Side view of the eye after the lash lift to evaluate the curl effect.
- 3. BEFORE Photo Full Face (Portrait)

  To assess the natural look and overall harmony.
- 4. AFTER Photo Full Face (Portrait)

  For evaluation of the final impression and facial balance.
- 5. Application Photo Lashes on Rod

  To check the placement technique lash separation, stretch, and alignment on the silicone shield or rod.
- 6. Application Photo Lotion Placement

  To ensure that the solution is applied correctly and does not touch the lash

tips (to avoid damage).

- 7. CLOSE-UP Photo with Eyes Closed For assessment of curl quality, symmetry, color saturation, and cleanliness.
- 8. CLOSE-UP Photo with Eyes Open
  To see the lifted lash result and how it affects the natural eye expression.
